Term structure and tentative dates of academic year 2021 at Temple University:

- Fall 2020 semester starts (Monday) August 24, 2020 and ends (Wednesday) December 16, 2020
- Spring 2021 semester starts (Monday) January 11, 2021 and ends (Wednesday) May 5, 2021

Orientation takes place during the week before classes begin. Students will be notified of arrival dates after acceptance.

- 3 Student creates online account, completes online application, and submits supplemental documents.
- 4 Global Programs reviews application.
- 5 Global Programs mails acceptance packet to home university.

Biographical page of passport

- Financial documents
- I-20 application
- List of current semester courses
- Official language scores
- Course Registration Process
- Official transcripts



Qualification for Global Programs

- Undergraduate students: full-time enrollment at home university for at least 2 academic years
- Graduate students: students must receive prior approval by receiving department at Temple University
- GPA 3.00/4.00 or higher (80% or 3.5/4.5) Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA while enrolled at Temple
- Official TOEFL (79 iBt, 550 paper-based, 213 computer-based) or IELTS (6.0) scores (TOEFL MyBest accepted)
